ABOUT THE COURSE



The field of nutritional epidemiology aims at understanding relationships between dietary intake, nutritional status and health outcomes. The course will be covered through 6 modules.

OBJECTIVES OF THE COURSE



- To understand various indicators of nutritional assessment and apply them for different research and programmatic outcomes.
- To understand sources, estimation and implications of measurement errors in nutritional epidemiological research.
- To understand, apply and critique the use of sampling and study designs to be able to get statistically meaningful data.
- To understand how to design a program intervention, implementation pathways, and tracking of program to achieve intended outcomes.
- To collaborate efficiently with epidemiologists, clinicians, nutritionists and statisticians on designing, planning, conducting and interpreting epidemiological research focused on the relationship of diet and disease.

COURSE CONTENT

The course will cover a set of 6 modules:

Module 1: Survey Methods (Conducted on October 26th-29th, 2018)

Module 2: Data management tools and advanced statistics (STATA) (Conducted on May 1st-4th, 2019)

Module 3: Nutritional Assessment Methods

Module 4: Planning and monitoring longitudinal studies and surveillance systems including geoinformatics

Module 5: Planning and developing Systematic reviews and meta-analysis and endnote referencing

Module 6: Project resource management, financial management, Programme monitoring and process evaluation and translation of policy into program.



COURSE TRANSACTION



The course will be transacted through lectures along with debates and discussions with experts. Practice sessions on use of softwares will be conducted.
